## Tim Kinney, 2023 Good Scouts' Award Recipient

The Scouts mission statement says that it will 'prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetime'. These are qualities that need to be exemplified particularly today when much of the exposure we get through our varied media outlets would lead us to believe that ethics and morals are fading into the past."
